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BATTLE OF OPTIMISM: VERBAL COMBAT OF THE INDIVIDUALS

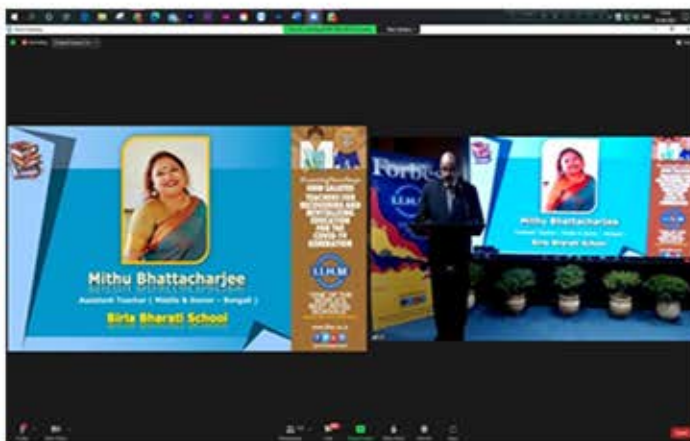
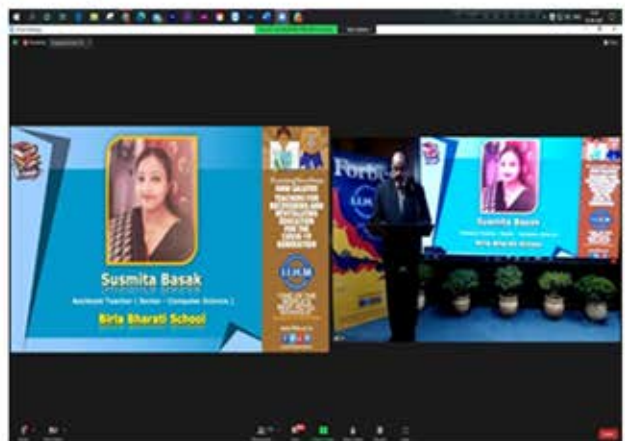


DATE OF EVENT : 14th August 2021
